- The first week of tuition is required before starting
- In the event of absence of my child/children from care due to illness, fees will not be reduced.
- In the event of absence of my child/children from care due to vacation, other than the free one week/year, fees will not be waived.
- In the event of a lapse in payment, a reminder notice will be sent out to the parents.
- Tuition will not be reduced due to holidays or weather related closings.
